Paul Hamaty is a local Treasure Coast artist with a passion for music. From concerto competition in high school to church organist in college, his love for great music has never diminished. He has performed at both the Blake and Cummings Libraries, at the Sunset Concerts sponsored by MartinArts, and is regularly part of the St. Mary's Concert Series.

As a vocalist, Paul sang with the choir of All Saints' Atlanta under the direction of Raymond Chenault as well as with the choir of Holy Trinity in Manhattan. He sings locally with the Treasure Coast Community Singers and at St. Mary's in Stuart.

In 2005, Paul commissioned *Requiem in C Minor* from Douglas Major, an American composer and former organist/choirmaster at Washington National Cathedral.

As a performer, Paul provides either background music or solo performances for events with piano or voice, or both, across many different musical genres.

Piano repertoire includes classical composers such as Satie, Chopin, Debussy, and Beethoven. Additional composers include George Winston, Yiruma, Lorie Line, and Jennifer Thomas. Of course, Paul plays all your favorite tunes from Broadway and the movies across the decades. Paul's rich baritone voice will serenade you to such well known pieces as *Fly me to the Moon*, *Music of the Night*, *Moon River*, *Sunrise Sunset* and many other of your favorites.
